Diabetics who come to us but are unable to pay for their insulin, are helped because of donations from individuals like you.

The Geneseo Parish Outreach Center has served 1482 clients since our inception in 2004. We partner with a number of dental, medical, and other health care specialists to provide care, including preventative care, for clients that need but cannot afford it. Diabetic and nutrition education, an emergency food pantry and weekly clinics are among our ongoing services.
